
U.S. EMERGENCY DEPARTMENT ENCOUNTERS FOR FIREARM INJURIES, 2009-2014

Trauma vs. Nontrauma Centers



Substantial opportunities exist to prevent recurrent firearm injury. Current models must expand beyond patients presenting at trauma centers with firearm assault injuries.
