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
Background

Financial Toxicity (FT)

- Extreme financial burden
- Higher chance of FT for Black, Hispanic patients, low income, working age Medicare/Medicaid

Financial Navigation (FN)

- Patient-level interventions to address FT
- Often social work led (Smith et al.)

The Impact of Financial Toxicity

At baseline over 50% of gynecologic cancer patients screened positive for financial distress (Liang 2021).

Increased financial toxicity is correlated with worse self-reported health and cost coping strategies (Bouberhan 2019).

46% of oncology navigators identified a lack of knowledge about resources as a barrier to assistance (Spencer 2018).



Background — NCI-Designated Cancer Centers

71 total cancer centers in 36 states

Three Levels:

- 7 Basic Laboratory Cancer Centers
- 11 Cancer Centers
- 53 Comprehensive Cancer Centers
 - Sample of 13 centers

To identify and characterize the availability of financial navigation services at NCI-designated comprehensive cancer centers


To issue recommendations for cancer centers' public websites to ease patient navigation available resources and services





- Assessed service availability (based on top 15 hits)









Variation in Search Results





'Financial toxicity' linked to lower survival, Roswell Park study in patients with head/neck cancers shows

HIGHLIGHTS

- Researchers asked patients about their concerns and quality of life
- Study is first to show that financial stress predicts overall survival
- Team exploring approaches to lessen the effects of stress on cancer patients

BUFFALO, N.Y. — Cancer treatment is likely to affect every aspect of a patient's life — their activities, relationships, eating habits, mental health, physical health and comfort, financial wellbeing. And when financial concerns weigh heavily on an individual who is in treatment for cancer, they can affect the outcome of that treatment. New research from Roswell Park Comprehensive Cancer Center provides the first evidence that a cancer patient's level of financial worry as they begin treatment predicts how likely it is that their treatment will be successful.





Recommendations for Easing Patient Navigation

Key Takeaway: difficult to navigate these websites

- 1. Provide information on financial toxicity (what it is, who is at risk...)
- 2. Add information regarding financial assistance applications in additional languages
- 3. Include direct links to Medicaid and state level insurance programs for patient enrollment
