

# 5 Major Social Domains

Negatively Impacts Child Health/Behavior at Vital Developmental Stages:

- **Infancy**: Developmental delay
- **Preschool ages**: Behavioral problems, obesity
- **School ages**: Poor academic performance, inattention
- Adolescence: Substance abuse, mental illness







# Findings

A Spanish-speaking caregiver enrolling in SECURE expressed her appreciation that the study materials and resource map are translated into Spanish. She explained that she usually cannot participate in these types of programs because of the language barrier. She asked for extra Spanish Resource Connects information cards to share with others, and emphasized the need for this type of resource in her communitu.

#### 1,035 families recruited

- 87% of those who used Resource
   Connects thought it was helpful
- 28% shared the link with someone else
  - 32% of families report making searches on Resource Connects
- Most commonly searched resources: food (43%), childcare (22%), WIC (20%)
